

AMI PACKET FOR GRADES 1 & 2

As I'm sure you have all seen, school has been canceled due to icy road conditions. This will be an AMI day. Since packets could not be sent home, I will be sending a few new ideas to you via text, but feel free to do any of the items you remember from the last AMI sheet as well.

Bible: read a Bible story/devotion, watch or listen to a Bible story, sing along with praise music. Practice our treasure verse which is Jeremiah 29:11. They could practice our new song for the next Education Sabbath, "Speak, Oh Lord" by the Gettys family.

Math: I will be sending login information for a new program called IXL, this will provide them with practice in all core subject areas that aligns with their individual scores on MAP testing. If you are able to find and print math fluency drills they could work on those. For reference, in the classroom, first graders are starting to learn about place value (ones and tens) and second graders are subtracting two digit numbers with regrouping.

Reading: Make sure your child reads the minimum 15 minutes a day, but today would be a great day for a little extra. If you still have the login information for RAZ-Kids they can read on that as well as reading through IXL.

I would like for every kid to do one writing assignment. This could be a short overview of their day or maybe a "book review" of one of the books they read. Encourage them to use complete sentences, capitalization, punctuation, and their best handwriting.

Science: we are wrapping up our unit on weather so watching the forecast or studying and tracking the precipitation are all excellent options. And of course Science Max and Magic School bus videos.

Any form of physical activity, indoors or out can count as PE.

Feel free to add any of your own creative ideas and track your work on a piece of paper that can be turned in. I will be texting again soon with IXL login information.
