Choose a DIFFERENT activity than you did last time.**

Language Arts:

- Spend some quiet time reading for your AR points. (REQUIRED)
- Write a story. (RECOMMENDED)
- Write a letter to someone. (RECOMMENDED)
- Write out your words 3x each from your spelling list for the current week.
- Write a "How-To" one-page (5+ paragraphs) essay describing how to do an activity you enjoy,

examples: preparing for a day of fishing, baking chocolate chip cookies, how to plan a perfect

slumber party, how to repair a flat tire on a car/bicycle, etc.

- Write a poem about snow, or another topic you have in mind.
- Read an article/short story out loud to a parent/grandparent about something interesting to you

or them. Write a summary about what you read.

• Log into IXL.com and look up transitive and intransitive verbs and take a lesson on it, or another language arts concept that you need a refresh on.

Bible:

• Design and color a stained-glass window on a piece of paper (or another creative type of picture) and add this week's memory verse to the bottom of the page.

- Read a devotional for the day and write a half page summary of it. (RECOMMENDED)
- Read a chapter from the Bible and summarize it.

Math:

- A math paper will be attached to complete.
- Work math IXL.com and do a concept that relates to what we have done in math this year.

Science:

• Find a science-related YouTube video you are interested in, watch it, and write a page summary about it.

- Read to find information on your favorite animals and write a one-page report about it.
- Research an illness, disease or disorder and write a one-page paper about it. You could also create a slide show using Google slides for me to watch.

Social Studies:

- Write a one-page report on a topic relating to Asia (current study topic in Social Studies class). Example topic: Himalayas. (RECCOMENDED)
- Find an online blank current map of the United States. Print it out. Label the states clearly with your handwriting and color.
- Draw or create online a travel brochure or poster about a place you would like to visit.
- Make a mini-book on the life of an inventor, president, or a time-period that interests you in our

United States history.

Art:

- Design/draw/color a funny cartoon strip
- Make a card to brighten a loved one's day and give it to them.
- Draw a pretty nature scene of your choice.
- Draw a realistic drawing of a person or an animal of your choice.
