Required Assignments

Math on IXL – If you have access to a computer, log into IXL (like Tuesday), click on "Skill plans", and then click on "Math" under the heading that says "Personal NWEA MAP Growth study plan". Spend at least 30 minutes working on math – take breaks as needed to keep your focus sharp!

Reading/Bible – Read I Samuel chapter 1 in your Bible. Do a 4-square response — 
Draw four big squares on a piece of paper.



In the first square, list all the characters you just read about.

In the second square, put the main events in order.

In the third square, write something the Bible story helped you learn.

In the fourth square, write something you would like to ask one of the characters in the Bible story.

Science – Collect 1 cup measuring cup of the ice/sleet that is on the ground. Make sure the measuring cup is full evenly to the top. Bring the cup inside and let the ice/sleet melt. Measure how much liquid is now in the measuring cup. Record your measurement of the melted liquid and write down why you think it is different than the frozen liquid.
